Response Statement - Skinner's Agalinis

Common Name: Skinner's Agalinis Scientific Name: Agalinis skinneriana

Status assessment by the Committee on the Status of Endangered Wildlife in Canada (COSEWIC): Endangered

How the Minister of the Environment intends to respond to the assessment: The above assessment confirms the classification of the Skinner's Agalinis which is already on Schedule 1, the List of Wildlife Species at Risk. This species will thus remain on the List as Endangered and activities will continue to be undertaken in a manner consistent with the purposes, and according to the timelines identified in, the Species at Risk Act.

Reason(s) for status designation provided by COSEWIC: A highly restricted annual species of tallgrass prairie known in Canada from only two populations in southwestern Ontario. Recent losses of subpopulations have resulted in a decline in range, habitat area and quality, and number of mature individuals.

Occurrence: Ontario

Competent Minister(s): Minister of Environment

Conservation activities underway: A National Recovery Team has been put in place and a recovery strategy for the Skinner's Agalinis (Agalinis skinneriana) is under development.
